The Arroyo Grande Sportsman's Club is offering a maximum \$1000 scholarship to a local college student. Applicants must have career goals that will have a positive impact on physical, social or political environment for the conservation/preservation and propagation of fish and wildlife and the natural resources within the United States; veterinary medicine or research and/or green technology.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND PROCESS

Complete the application below and then,

1. Write an essay that contains;
 - a. A description of your interest, knowledge and involvement in the protection, conservation, propagation and preservation of fish and wildlife as well as the natural resources within the United States; forest service; fish and game service and/or wildlife and environmental law. A paper written for a class or one written for this application will serve the purpose equally well.
 - b. A brief description of the courses you have completed pertaining to the information provided in item 1a; and a description of your career goals.
 - c. Why you think you are deserving of the scholarship.
2. Obtain **two letters of recommendation** from people familiar with your character and potential for contributing to the above causes. While at least one letter should be from a college or university professor, letters from persons outside the educational setting who know you and your involvement in the issues above and your academic achievements, extra curricular activities/volunteer associations. Those chosen to write letters of recommendation should mail the letters directly to: **AGSC Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 274, Arroyo Grande, CA 93421.**
3. Obtain and send a copy of all college transcripts to: **AGSC Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 274, Arroyo Grande, CA 93421.**
4. Only applications that are complete and **postmarked or hand delivered to a member of the AGSC Board no later than May 4, 2020 will be considered.**
5. All completed applications will be acknowledged and considered. The Committee will inform applicants of the final decision **by mail in mid June.**
6. Applicants who are considered, as finalists will be asked to meet with the AGSC Scholarship Committee for a personal interview.

Please note: AGSC will not be able to return application materials, so applicants should retain a copy of the application and attachments for their own files.

The AGSC reserves the option of not awarding a scholarship if no applicants are sufficiently qualified.
